Literacy and numeracy assessments and learning inventories have been completed with each student.

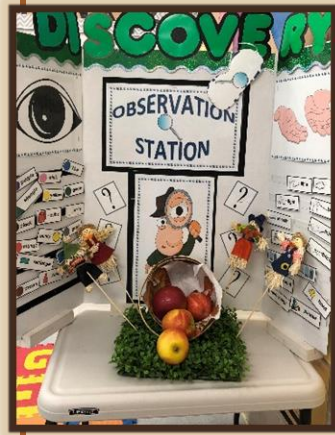
All students were reminded of our rules, beliefs and bottom lines which fall under three categories:

They have also enjoyed reading many stories. They have been focusing on stories starting with the letter 'A' as well as several stories about apples.



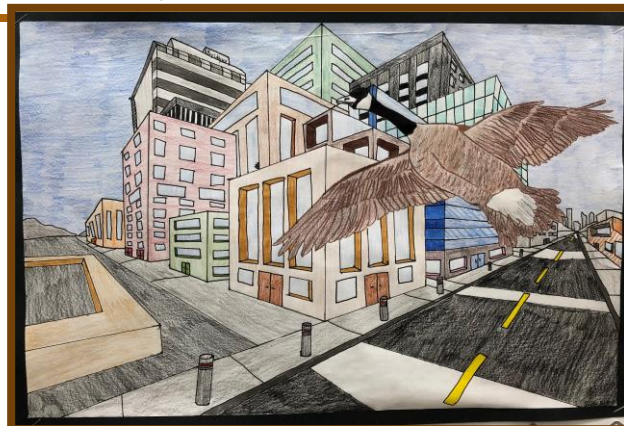
