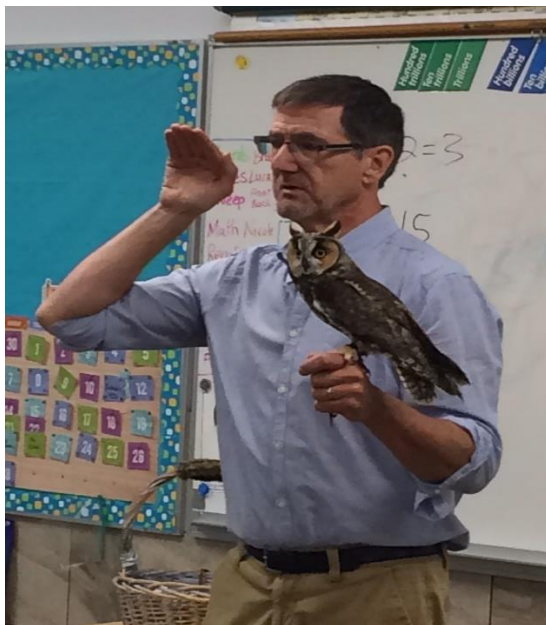


May flew by faster than the birds we have been studying! We have also been learning about graphing, fractions, decimals, the human body, Manitoba, poetry, fire safety and much more.
